What does Bethlehem Housing & Support Services do?

Bethlehem Housing and Support Services has been turning lives around for almost 30 years.

We are currently the only organization in Niagara offering supportive transitional and permanent housing for men, women and their children with a focus on families who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless due to issues with poverty, physical disability, mental health, domestic violence and family breakdown.



After leaving a violent relationship and struggling with alcoholism, Valerie found herself homeless in 2014. During the cold winter months she decided she had enough and she looked to get help. She was introduced to Bethlehem Housing and Support Services, where her journey to recovery began.

Valerie was put in contact with support workers at Bethlehem and in July 2015 she had a place to call home at Bethlehem Place. Here she was able to talk about trauma, the disease of addictions and how to cope with both so that she can move forward in life. "Bethlehem assisted me in becoming more secure with my life and finding peace within myself."

The support from the workers at Bethlehem, along with their hard work and dedication, is why Valerie is at the place she is today. "Bethlehem Housing is here to support you and guide you towards a better life."

What is Empty Bowls?



Niagara's finest chefs prepare and serve their favourite soup in one-of-a-kind bowls created by local potters. Included as the perfect complement are Niagara wines, specialty beverages and delicious sweets. Over 300 guests enjoyed an evening of great food and drink in an energizing atmosphere at Club Roma at the 12th Annual Empty Bowls event in 2017.

The event continues throughout the year as guests take their empty bowl home as a reminder of those who struggle to meet basic living needs and secure affordable housing throughout our community. Empty Bowls raised over \$30,000 in 2017 for programming at Bethlehem Housing and Support Services.

104 households lived in our permanent supportive housing buildings, Kenmore and Gensis Court, in 2016 - 2017

49 families including 79 children lived in our transitional housing building, Bethlehem Place, in 2016 - 2017

132 individuals were homeless or at risk of becoming homeless

39% of the residents living at Bethlehem Place are survivors/victims of domestic violence

84% of those who moved out of supported housing transitioned to stable and secure housing
