HOME OWNERSHIP



In March 2023, the residential average sale price of a home was \$641,600 a 66% increase since December 2017. 1



The average mortgage carrying cost is \$1,848 / month. ²

MARKET RENT



The average rent for a 2 bedroom apartment is \$1260 / month. 3



The vacancy rate for a 2 bedroom apartment is 2.7%. ³

AFFORDABLE HOUSING



Over 9000 households are on the waitlist for subsidized housing representing about 16,000 to 17,000 individuals. ⁴



The average wait time for a 2 bedroom subsidized housing unit is 6.75 years. ⁵

WHAT IS AFFORDABLE HOUSING?

Housing is considered to be affordable when a household spends less than 30% of its pre-tax income on adequate shelter. Households that spend more than 30% of their income on shelter are deemed to be in core housing need. Those that spend 50% or more on shelter are in severe housing need.



25,000+ families are currently in core housing need in Niagara. ⁶
