After fleeing violence, Maya and her children found safety and stability through Bethlehem Housing and Support Services, gaining access to mental health care, education, and the chance to rebuild their lives with hope for the future.

[6] I came to Bethlehem Housing and Support Services to be helped because I was coming from a violent relationship and was living in a shelter at the time.

Some of my goals have been to get a job so that I can sustain my family, and to get myself back to school so I can get a better job. My goal is also to get my refugee application approved by working with the lawyers and making sure my children are living comfortably. Bethlehem has been so supportive that I have been able to understand my surroundings where we live. My children go to school, and they have provided a safe place for me and my children. They have assisted with treatment for mental health for me and my children. Now I can apply for college and can try and get a job for myself.

The support given to my life personally is help with my mental health and children's mental health, a safe and affordable place to stay. They have encouraged me to be able to meet my goals and have supported my growth.

I see myself in the future meeting my goals and having a sustainable job that will be able to take care of me and my family. I hope that I may be able to support and help others, as I was given this chance to a better life with my children. My children and I are really grateful for the opportunity that has been given to us by Bethlehem.
