In partnership with the community, we provide affordable housing and services to support the personal growth of individuals and families.

Our vision is to create a vibrant, caring and inclusive Niagara where everyone has a home and the support they need to succeed.

## What We Do

### Transitional Housing Program

A staged approach to supporting our clients in making a successful transition to safe and stable housing. Clients live at Bethlehem Place for approximately one year and are required to participate in support services, including one-on-one coaching with a Community Support Worker and a variety of personal capacity building programs.

### Permanent Supportive Housing

Our St. Catharines and Niagara Falls residences provide permanent affordable and/or subsidized housing for individuals and families of low to moderate income. Our on-site support services may include information referrals and connection to community services, social and recreational activities, and advocacy when needed.

## Who We Help

We are the only organization in Niagara offering supportive transitional and permanent housing for men, women and their children.

We have a focus on families who are homeless due to issues with poverty, physical disability, mental health, domestic violence and family breakdown.

## Community Outreach Support

In-house and community support services for current and former residences, as well as people living in the community. Our Community Outreach Support Workers meet with our clients in the community and work with them to develop a plan for achieving their personal goals.
